



Inexpensive responsible way to reduce greenhouse gasses.

Any easy way to save electricity and reduce greenhouse gases at zero cost is to report streetlights that remains on during the day.

GV Community Energy director Doug Small reckons he recently saved 100 kg of carbon dioxide emissions with a simple phone call to Powercor.

“I recently noticed two Kyabram streetlights were on during day for about 60 days and wondered why”.

After noting the pole numbers he rang Powercor on 132 412 selected option 3 and spoke to an operator who quickly located poles and alerted a work crew to have them fixed.

And in two days the streetlights were fixed.
